Atrium Library

Because this space will be the heart of the school, it is our top priority! It will set the tone for our school, be a library and be home to many formal and informal gatherings. As a library, we want to fill it with LOTS of books and cozy, small spaces for reading, studying, and meeting. At other times, we hope to whisk away the library and convert the space into an area for concerts, small assemblies, and student performances.

Playground

The school needs two outdoor play spaces that encourage physical activity and fitness and are tucked in natural settings. We plan for one playground for our youngest children and one for the older students.

Learning Garden

We envision a special area for outdoor discoveries that will include raised beds for classroom planting projects, a “sensory” garden for flowers as well as edible and tactile plants, stone pavers to create pathways, outdoor work tables, and a small shed.

Art Room

We imagine this area as a bright, somewhat messy, and inspirational creative space outfitted with large tables and stools, shelves for storage and art display, easels, and drying racks.

Family Resource Room

The Family Resource Room will give Bridge Boston community families a home base within the school community including a stackable washer and dryer for laundry, comfortable seating area for families, 2-3 work stations with computers, and shelving for family resource materials.

Science Room and STEM materials

Over time we want to build an exceptional middle school science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) program to meet the needs of the changing economy. We hope to create a science lab complete with student lab tables and stools, computers, robotics kits, Foss kits, a teacher demonstration table, a 3-D printer and design/engineering supplies.
